

## **MEASURES FOR THE PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INFECTIONS APPLICABLE DURING THE STATE OF ALERT**

1. Starting with 15.05.2020, in commercial spaces, means of public transport, at work and in other enclosed spaces, the obligation to wear a mask is established, so that the nose and mouth are covered.

2. Public institutions and authorities, as well as public and private economic operators, have the obligation to organize the activity so that the work is carried out from the employees' home, and if the activity does not allow this, to take measures to:

a) ensure epidemiological triage consisting in the control of the temperature of the own staff and of the visitors, at the control-access points in the premises;

b) mandatory disinfection of hands before entering work spaces;

c) observance of the rules regarding the activity in the offices with common spaces (open space) and of the rules regarding the operation of the accommodation units in hotel regime;

d) postponement of the work schedule, for the entities with a number of more than 50 employees, so that the beginning, respectively the end of the work schedule is carried out at intervals of at least 1 hour, during at least 3 hours, in tranches of at least 20 % of staff.

3. Public institutions and economic operators that carry out commercial activities / work with the public involving the access of persons inside the buildings, take measures for the organization of the activity, as follows:

a) the access must be organized so as to ensure a minimum area of 4 sqm for each client / person and a minimum distance of 2 m between any two close persons;

b) not to allow the access of the persons whose body temperature, measured at the entrance to the enclosure, exceeds 37.30C;

c) to ensure the disinfection of the exposed surfaces and to avoid the agglomeration of people, especially in the areas of cash registers / counters.

4. Passenger transport operators, public and private, shall organize their activities in such a way as to comply with specific rules.

5. (1) In order to prevent the spread of SARS-CoV-2 infections, the organization and holding of rallies, demonstrations, concerts or any other gatherings in open spaces, as well as cultural, scientific, artistic, sporting or entertainment activities, shall be prohibited. gambling, fitness activities, swimming pool activities and indoor spa activities.

(2) Are exempted from the provisions of par. 1 the following activities:

a) the activities organized by the servants of religious cults, with the participation of the public, which takes place only outside the places of worship, as well as practices and private rituals inside places of worship (with the participation of the maximum 16 persons) is carried

out in compliance with prevention and protection measures established. Religious services held in public places, outside the places of worship cult, are not considered public assemblies;

b) personal care activities that take place in specially designed spaces and in compliance with prevention and protection measures;

c) the training activities of the performance athletes in the training camps, which are carried out in compliance with prevention and protection measures;

d) the cultural activities carried out in the specially designated spaces, respectively at the level museums, libraries and exhibition halls prevention and protection measures;

e) outdoor recreational sports activities, such as cycling, hiking, running, boating, mountaineering, hunting, fishing and the like, which take place with the participation of at most 3 people who do not live together.

6. (1) The activity of serving and consuming the products in common dining areas inside restaurants, hotels, motels, boarding houses, cafes or other public places, as well as on the terraces outside them locations.

(2) They are exempted from the provisions of par. 1 food preparation activities as well as marketing of food and alcoholic and non - alcoholic beverages, not involve customers staying in spaces intended for this purpose, such as drivein ', "Room-service", customer delivery, "take-away" etc.

7. (1) The activity of retail sale of products and services in shopping centers with a built area of more than 15,000 sq.m, in which several economic operators operate, is temporarily suspended.

(2) Are exempted from the provisions of par. 1 the following activities:

a) the sale of food, veterinary, pharmaceutical products, medical optics products and services and cleaning services;

b) the sale of electronic and household appliances, only if the economic operators ensure their delivery to the buyer's domicile / headquarters;

c) the activity carried out by the economic operators within the shopping centers that have the access provided directly from outside the premises and the communication with the rest of the complex is interrupted.

8. The obligation to maintain the operation of residential care and assistance centers for the elderly, residential centers for children and adults, with and without disabilities, as well as for other vulnerable groups and to impose conditions of isolation of staff during their stay at work.

9. (1) The entry on the territory of Romania, through the crossing points of the state border, of foreign citizens and stateless persons is prohibited.

(2) They are exempted from the provisions of par. 1 the following foreign nationals:

a) family members of Romanian citizens;

- b) family members of nationals of other EU Member States, or of the European Economic Area or of the Swiss Confederation, with residence in Romania;
- c) persons in possession of a long-stay visa, a residence permit or a document equivalent to a residence permit issued by the authorities, or a document equivalent to them issued by the authorities of other states, according to EU law;
- d) persons traveling in the professional interest, proven by visa, residence permit or other equivalent document;
- e) diplomatic or consular personnel, personnel of international organizations, military personnel or personnel who can provide humanitarian aid;
- f) passengers in transit, including those repatriated as a result of the granting of consular protection;
- g) passengers traveling for imperative reasons;
- h) persons in need of international protection or for other humanitarian reasons.

10. 1. The suspension of flights by aviation operators to Austria, Belgium, the Swiss Confederation, France, Germany, Iran, Italy, the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, Spain, the States shall be extended. United States of America, Turkey and Iran, and from these countries to Romania for all airports in Romania, for a period of 14 days, starting with 15.05.2020.

(2) They are exempted from the provisions of par. 1 the following flight categories:

- performed with state aircraft;
- transport of goods and / or correspondence;
- humanitarian or providing emergency medical services;
- for search-rescue or emergency response, at the request of a public authorities in Romania;
- for the purpose of transporting technical intervention teams, upon request economic operators established in Romania;
- non-commercial technical landings;
- positioning of aircraft, without commercial cargo (ferry);
- techniques for carrying out works on aircraft;
- performed by air carriers holding an operating license in accordance with European Union regulations, by irregular flights (charter), for the transport of seasonal workers or for the repatriation of foreign nationals, from Romania to other states, with the approval of the Romanian Civil Aviation Authority and the authority competent authorities of the State of destination;
- flights performed by air carriers holding an operating license in accordance with European Union regulations, by irregular flights (charter), from other states to Romania for the repatriation of Romanian citizens, with the approval of the Romanian Civil Aviation

Authority, based on the agreement of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and the Ministry Foreign Affairs;

- flights performed by air carriers licensed to operate in accordance with European Union regulations, by charter flights, for the transport of workers in the transport sector provided for in Annex no. 3 to the Communication on the implementation of Green Lanes under the Guidelines on border management measures to protect health and ensure the availability of essential goods and services - C (2020) 1897, of 23.03.2020, from Romania to other states and from other states to Romania, with the approval of the Romanian Civil Aviation Authority, of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and of the competent authority of the destination state.

11. 1. International road transport of persons shall be suspended by regular services, special regular services and occasional services in international traffic, for all journeys by transport operators to Italy, Spain, France, Germany, Austria, Belgium, the Swiss Confederation. , The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Kingdom of the Netherlands and Turkey and from these countries to Romania, until 01 June 2020.

(2) The provisions of par. (1) does not apply to the international carriage of persons by road by occasional services, if the following cumulative conditions are met:

a) only persons who: have a valid employment contract in the territory of the state of destination, have a valid right of residence in the state of destination or return to Romania from the state in which they worked or lived are transported;

b) there is the agreement, approval or opinion of the transit States and the State of destination regarding the conduct of the flight;

c) the road transport operator informs the Romanian Road Authority - A.R.R. from the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, at least 24 hours before the start of the race, regarding the performance of the race, as well as all other data and information provided by the specific legislation in force; together with that information, the carrier shall provide the consent of all the States of transit and the State of destination for the carriage to be carried out;

d) the road transport operator carrying out the transport, together with the recruitment agency and the persons to be transported shall take all necessary measures to comply with the rules and recommendations of the authorities responsible for avoiding congestion, protection and safety measures for passengers and drivers.

12. The activity of the dental offices is resumed for the non-emergency cases, with the observance of the measures for prevention and control of the spread of infections;

13. The resumption of outpatient medical care for non-emergency cases with no potential for aggravation is resumed, provided that the activity is organized so that consultations are carried out only with prior appointment and prohibiting patients from being placed in waiting areas, as well as hospitalization activities. of patients who are not medical emergencies, at the level of non-COVID health units, with the maintenance of access bans of the relatives, being mandatory the organization of an information system about the condition of hospitalized patients.

14. (1) It is established, starting with 15.05.2020, for all persons coming to Romania from abroad, the measure of quarantine / isolation at home together with the family / relatives with whom they live together, and for those who do not have the possibility to fulfill conditions for the above-mentioned measure or request it so as not to expose their family, the institutionalized quarantine measure may be chosen, in specially designated spaces provided by the authorities.

2) They are exempted from the provisions of par. (1) the following categories of persons:

- a) drivers of goods vehicles with a maximum authorized capacity of more than 2.4 tons;
- b) members of the European Parliament, parliamentarians and staff belonging to the national system of defense of public order and national security;
- c) aircraft pilots and flight crew;
- d) locomotive drivers and railway staff;
- e) seafarers disembarking from inland waterway vessels flying the Romanian flag in a Romanian port and not showing symptoms associated with COVID-19, provided that the employer provides the certificate for international transport workers and personal protective equipment against COVID-19, when moving from the ship to the location where it can be contacted between trips;
- f) cross-border workers who, upon entering Romania from Hungary, Bulgaria, Serbia, Ukraine and Moldova, do not show symptoms associated with COVID-19;
- g) employees of the Romanian economic operators who perform works, according to the concluded contracts, outside the Romanian territory, on their return to the country if they do not show COVID-19 associated symptoms and prove the contractual relations with the beneficiary outside the national territory;
- h) the representatives of the foreign companies that have subsidiaries / branches / representations on the national territory, if at the entrance on the Romanian territory they do not present associated symptoms COVID-19 and prove the contractual relations with the economic entities on the national territory;
- i) persons entering Romania for the performance of activities of use, installation, commissioning, maintenance, service of medical equipment and technology, as well as equipment in the fields of science, economics, defense, public order and national security, if they do not present symptoms associated with COVID-19 and prove the contractual relations with the beneficiary / beneficiaries from the Romanian territory;
- j) members of diplomatic missions, consular offices and other diplomatic missions accredited in Bucharest, holders of diplomatic passports, staff assimilated to diplomatic staff, as well as members of the Romanian Diplomatic and Consular Corps and holders of diplomatic and service passports, if at entry into Romania no symptoms associated with SARS-CoV-2;
- k) the employees of the national system of public order defense and national security who return to Romania from missions executed abroad, if at the entrance to Romania they do not present symptoms associated with SARS-CoV-2.

(3) Persons who do not comply with the quarantine / isolation measures at home will be placed in institutionalized quarantine for a period of 14 days and obliged to bear the value of accommodation and food during the institutionalized quarantine.

(4) The persons in institutionalized quarantine on 15.05.2020, remain in quarantine in the respective spaces until the end of the 14-day period.

15. (1) The measure of quarantine of some buildings, areas, localities at the request of the county committees for emergency situations is established, by order of the action commander, based on the analyzes performed by the public health directorates and endorsed by INSP.

(2) The quarantine measures instituted during the state of emergency and which have not been revoked shall be maintained under the conditions of par. 1.

16. The temporary closure, in whole or in part, of some state border crossing points is maintained, as follows:

I. At the Romanian-Hungarian border:

1. Turnu, Arad County (except for the movement of cross-border workers);
2. Salonta, Bihor county - railway and road (except for the movement of workers cross-border by road);
3. Săcuieni, Bihor county (except for the movement of cross-border workers);
4. Valea lui Mihai, Bihor county - railway and road (except for railway traffic freight);
5. Carei, Satu Mare county.

II. At the Romanian-Bulgarian border:

1. Negru Vodă, Constanța County;
2. Lipnița, Constanța county;
3. Dobromir, Constanța County;
4. Zimnicea, Teleorman county;
5. Turnu Măgurele, Teleorman county;
6. Bechet, Dolj County (except for freight traffic).

III. At the Romanian-Ukrainian border:

1. Sighetu Marmăției, Maramureș County;
2. Isaccea, Tulcea County.

IV. At the Romanian-Moldovan border:

1. Rădăuți-Prut, Botoșani county;
2. Oancea, Galati county.

V. At the Romanian-Serbian border:

1. Iron Gates II, Mehedinți County;
2. Drobeta-Turnu Severin, Mehedinți County (except for freight traffic);
3. Orșova, Mehedinți county;
4. Moldova Nouă, Caraș-Severin County;
5. Naidăș, Caraș-Severin County;
6. Vălcani, Timiș County;
7. Stamora-Moravița, Timiș County - railway (except for freight traffic);
8. Lunga, Timiș County;
9. Foeni, Timiș County;
10. Jimbolia, Timiș County - railway (except for freight traffic).

17. (1) Starting with 15.05.2020, it is allowed the movement of persons outside the home / household, inside the localities, in compliance with the measures to prevent the spread of infection and avoid the formation of pedestrian groups larger than 3 persons not belonging to the same family .

(2) At the same time, it is ordered to reopen the parks to the public, except for children's playgrounds and in compliance with the general prevention and protection measures.

(3) The prohibition of the movement of persons outside the metropolitan locality / area is established with the following exceptions:

- a) travel in professional interest, including between home / household and place (s) of professional activity and back;
- b) travel for humanitarian or voluntary purposes;
- c) travel for agricultural activities;
- d) travel for the marketing of agri - food products by agricultural producers;
- e) travel for the care or administration of one property from another locality or the issuance of documents necessary for obtaining rights;
- f) travel to participate in programs or procedures in training centers treatment;
- g) travel for other justified reasons, such as care / accompaniment children / family members, care of a relative / relative or person in maintenance, assistance to the elderly, sick or disabled, death a family member;
- h) travel for medical assistance that cannot be postponed or made from a distance;
- i) travel for individual recreational-sports activities carried out in the free air (cycling, hiking, running, boating, mountaineering, hunting, fishing and more) with the participation of at most 3 people.

j) travel for participation in family events, with a limited number of people and compliance with the rules of social distancing;

k) travel for the acquisition, service, performance of ITP or other operations of vehicle maintenance, activities that cannot be performed in the locality of home.

(4) At the request of the institutions empowered to exercise control over compliance with the measures established during the alert state, the situations excepted according to the provisions of paragraph (2) are justified by declaration on his own responsibility.

18. (1) The measure of suspending the courses from all educational units and institutions until the end of the school / university year is maintained.

(2) It is allowed to carry out, after 02.06.2020, some preparatory activities, for a period of 2 weeks, for the students of the final classes (8th, 12th and 13th), as well as for the organization of national examinations in compliance with the prevention measures.

19. The operational coordination of ambulance services by the emergency inspectorates and the Local Police by the police inspectorates within the Ministry of Internal Affairs is maintained, as well as the measures ordered regarding the medical staff in the medical offices of the units / institutions of education regarding the provision of public health directorates, except for the period 02-12.06.2020, as well as during the conduct of national examinations.

20. In the situation of establishing the state of alert according to the law, during it, the Ministry of National Defense supports, upon request, the Ministry of Internal Affairs with personnel and means for:

a) ensuring the security and protection of some objectives whose protection is ensured by the Romanian Gendarmerie;

b) the transport of personnel, materials and equipment for the fulfillment of specific missions;

c) epidemiological triage, medical assistance.

21. The possibility for employers to have the measure of preventive isolation at the workplace or in specially dedicated areas is maintained where people do not have access from outside, for staff holding essential functions to ensure the functioning of the production, transmission and distribution of electricity and natural gas, maintenance and upkeep of specific equipment and installations, as well as other activities of supply, respectively extraction, production and processing of resources and energy raw materials and / or semi-processes necessary for the proper functioning of the National Energy System, in accordance with its own plans continuity of core activities.
