

**MILITARY ORDINANCE no. 10 of April 27, 2020 on measures to prevent the spread
COVID-19**

Article 1

(1) The movement of persons who have reached the age of 65, outside the dwelling / household, is allowed only in the situations set out below.

(2) Irrespective of the time slot, the movement of persons who have reached the age of 65, outside housing, is strictly allowed for the following reasons:

a) travel in professional interest, including between home / household and the place / places where the professional activity takes place and back, as well as under the conditions of art. 1 para. (1), (2) and (5) of the Military Ordinance no. 8/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, as subsequently amended;

b) travel for medical care that cannot be postponed or performed remotely, including treatments of oncology, dialysis, etc., using public transport, with their own means of transport or the family / supporters or, as the case may be, the means of medical transport specially destined;

c) travel for agricultural activities;

d) the movement of agricultural producers for the sale of agri-food products.

(3) In the time intervals 7.00-11.00 and 19.00-22.00 the movement of persons who have reached the age of 65, outside their housing, is strictly allowed for the following reasons:

a) travel for the provision of goods covering the basic needs of persons and animals company / domestic, including travel under the conditions of art. 1 para. (3) and (5) of the Military Ordinance no. 8/2020 regarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, as subsequently amended;

b) moving for justified reasons, such as caring for / accompanying a minor, assisting other elderly, sick people or with disabilities, or in the event of the death of a family member;

c) short trips, close to the home / household, related to the individual physical activity of the persons (with exclusion of any collective physical activities), as well as for the needs of pets.

(4) In order to verify the reason for moving in the situations provided in par. (2) and (3) the provisions of art. 4 of the Military Ordinance no. 3/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, as amended, shall apply accordingly.

(5) The measures shall be applied starting with the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

Article 2

(1) Economic operators who market food and products of strict necessity and who carry out their business activity under the conditions ordered by military ordinances during the state of emergency will organize their work schedule to facilitate and ensure, as a matter of priority, access for persons over 65 years of age between 7.00 and 11.00 and from 19.00 to 22.00.

(2) The measure shall be applied starting with the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

Article 3

(1) The measure suspending flights by air economic operators to and from Spain is extended to Romania, for all airports in Romania, for a period of 14 days, starting with April 28 2020 until May 11, 2020 inclusive.

(2) The suspension of flights to Austria, Belgium, the Swiss Confederation, the United States of America is hereby extended to The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, the Kingdom of the Netherlands, Turkey and Iran and from these countries to Romania, for all airports in Romania, for a period of 13 days, starting with May 2, 2020 until May 14, 2020 inclusive.

(3) The measure of suspension of flights to Italy and from this country to Romania is extended for all airports in Romania, for a period of 12 days, starting with May 3, 2020 until May 14, 2020 inclusive.

(4) The measure of suspension of flights to France and Germany and from these countries to Romania is extended, for all airports in Romania, for a period of 10 days, starting with May 5, 2020 until May 14 2020 inclusive.

(5) The measures provided in par. (1) - (4) does not apply to flights performed by state aircraft, transport flights cargo and correspondence, humanitarian or providing emergency medical services, technical services, and non-commercial landings techniques.

Article 4

(1) During the state of emergency, the registered postal items may be handed over to the recipients by the National Post Office - S.A. staff by entering it in the mailbox or, failing that, by displaying it at the address to the addressee, except for procedural documents.

(2) The National Company Romanian Post - S.A. it has the obligation to establish the institutional framework and the responsibility for the manner in which the activity provided in par. (1).

(3) The measure shall be applied starting with the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

Article 5

On the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, its applicability ceases:

a) the provisions of art. 2 and art. 3 of the Military Ordinance no. 3/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 242 of March 24, 2020, with subsequent amendments;

b) the provisions of art. 1 and art. 2 of the Military Ordinance no. 4/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 257 of March 29, 2020, with subsequent amendments.

Article 6

(1) The following are empowered to ensure the application and observance of the provisions of this military ordinance:

a) The Romanian Police, the Romanian Gendarmerie and the local police, for the measures provided in art. 1;

b) The Romanian Police, the Romanian Gendarmerie, the local police and the National Authority for Consumer Protection, for the measure provided in art. 2;

c) The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, for the measure provided in art. 3;

(2) Failure to comply with the measures provided in art. 1-3 entails disciplinary, civil, contraventional or criminal liability,

In accordance with Art. 27 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, approved with modifications and completions by Law no. 453/2004, with subsequent amendments and completions.

(3) The staff of the institutions provided in par. (1) is empowered to establish contraventions and to apply sanctions, in accordance with the provisions of art. 29 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, approved with modifications and completions by Law no. 453/2004, with subsequent amendments and completions.

Article 7

(1) This military ordinance is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

(2) The providers of audiovisual media services have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, for at least two days from the date of publication, on the content of this military ordinance.

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
