

**MILITARY ORDER no. 3 of March 24, 2020 regarding measures to prevent spread of COVID-19**

Article 1

The movement of all persons outside the home / household is prohibited, with the following exceptions:

- a) travel in professional interest, including between home / household and the place (s) of professional activity and back;
- b) travel for the provision of goods that cover the basic needs of the persons and the pets / pets, as well as goods necessary for the professional activity;
- c) travel for healthcare that cannot be postponed or performed remotely;
- d) displacement for justified reasons, such as caring / accompanying the child, assistance of elderly, sick or disabled or death of a family member;
- e) short trips, near the house / household, related to the individual physical activity of the persons (excluding any team sports activities), as well as to the needs of the pets / pets;
- f) movement for blood donation, to blood transfusion centers;
- g) travel for humanitarian or voluntary purposes;
- h) travel for agricultural activities;
- i) displacement of agricultural producers for the marketing of agri-food products.

Article 2

The movement of persons who have reached the age of 65, outside the home / household, is allowed only during the hours 11.00-13.00, strictly for the following reasons:

- a) travel to provide goods that cover the basic needs of persons and pets / pets;
- b) travel for medical assistance that cannot be delayed or performed remotely;
- c) displacement for justified reasons, such as caring / accompanying a minor, assisting other elderly, sick or disabled persons, or in the case of the death of a family member;
- d) short trips, near the house / household, related to the individual physical activity of the persons (excluding any collective physical activities), as well as to the needs of the pets / pets.

Article 3

The circulation of the persons provided for in art. 2, outside the house / household, is allowed outside the time interval 11.00-13.00, if this is done in professional interest or for agricultural activities.

Article 4

(1) To prove reason for circulation:

- a) the employees present the service card or the certificate issued by the employer;
- b) the authorized natural persons, the holders of the individual enterprises, the members of the family enterprises, the free professionals and the persons who practice agricultural activities present a declaration on their own responsibility, completed in advance.

(2) To verify the reason for the move in situations other than those provided in par. (1) a declaration is submitted on its own responsibility, completed in advance.

(3) The declaration on its own responsibility must include the first and last name, date of birth, address of place of residence, reason and place of travel, date and signature.

(4) The certificate issued by the employer or the declaration on its own responsibility may be presented to the personnel of the authorized authorities and by telephone, tablet or similar electronic device.

(5) The measure shall be applied from March 25, 2020, at 12.00.

#### Article 5

(1) The measure of isolation at home or, as the case may be, quarantine for all persons entering Romania is established.

(2) The measure shall be applied from March 25, 2020, at 12.00.

#### Article 6

(1) The authorities of the local public administration have the obligation to identify and keep the records of the homeless, as well as to ensure their shelter and care.

(2) The records of homeless persons shall be updated and reported weekly at the County Center / of the Bucharest Municipality for coordination and management of the intervention.

(3) The measure shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

#### Article 7

(1) Public institutions and economic operators have the obligation to mark the area for the access of citizens / customers and the area of public relations / sale with visible signs to guide people in keeping a safety distance of at least 1.5 meters.

(2) The managers of the agri-food markets have the obligation to organize the sales activity in such a way as to maintain a social distance between the agricultural producers, traders and buyers. Traders and agricultural producers in the agri-food markets are obliged to take protective measures against the spread of COVID-19, respectively to wear gloves and masks.

(3) The measure shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

#### Article 8.

(1) All flights by air operators to France and Germany and from France and Germany to Romania shall be suspended for all airports in Romania for a period of 14 days.

(2) The measure does not apply to flights made with state aircraft, freight and mail, humanitarian or emergency medical services, as well as non-commercial technical authorizations.

(3) The measure shall be applied from March 25, 2020, at 23.00, the time of Romania.

#### Article 9

(1) The access of the pilots on board of the ships is prohibited, arriving from the red / yellow risk areas in the Romanian seaports, if they do not have the protective equipment established by the Public

Health Directorate of Constanta or if the ships have not completed the 14-day quarantine period from the last port of call located in a red / yellow risk area.

(2) The access of the maritime and fluvio-maritime vessels to the ports located on the maritime Danube shall be prohibited, until the 14-day quarantine period from the last port of call located in a red / yellow area, in the following two parking areas in anchor:

- a) the port of Sulina, for vessels coming from the Black Sea;
- b) The Danube, naval mile 44, for ships coming from the Bâstroe canal.

(3) The measure shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

#### Article 10

The Ministry of National Defense ensures, at the request of the Minister of Internal Affairs:

- a) taking over some objectives whose protection is currently provided by the Romanian Gendarmerie;
- b) personnel and logistical means for supporting public order activities;
- c) personnel and logistical means to support the activities of the Romanian Border Police, at the state border crossing points.

#### Article 11

In order to verify compliance with the conditions of quarantine or isolation at home, the national security institutions will design communications systems and computer applications, necessary for the Ministry of Internal Affairs, the Ministry of Health and local authorities, to communicate in real time and permanently with the quarantined or isolated persons at home.

#### Article 12

(1) Documents that expire during the state of emergency, issued by the public authorities, may be exchanged within 90 days from the date of cessation of the state of emergency.

#### Article 13

(1) After paragraph 2 of article 2 of the Military Ordinance no. 2/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 232 of March 21, 2020, a new paragraph, paragraph 21, is introduced, referring to the activities allowed in the shopping centers, with the following content:

"(21) The temporary suspension of the commercial activity according to paragraph (1) does not apply:

- a) the sale of the electronic and household products by the economic operators that ensure the delivery at the buyer's home / office;
- b) sale of medical optics products and services. "

(2) The measures provided in par. (1) shall apply from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

#### Article 14

(1) Are am entitled to ensure the application and observance of the provisions of this military ordinance:

- a) The Romanian police, the Romanian Gendarmerie and the local police for the measures provided in art. 1-4;
  - b) The Romanian police, the Romanian Gendarmerie, the local police, the General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations and the subordinate structures, the public health directions and the leaders of the local public administration authorities, for the measure provided in art. 5;
  - c) The Romanian Police, the Romanian Gendarmerie, the local police, the National Agency for Fiscal Administration, the National Authority for Consumer Protection and the leaders of the local public administration authorities, for the measure provided in art. 7;
  - d) The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, for the measure provided in art. 8;
  - e) The Romanian Naval Authority and the directions of public health, for the measure provided in art. 9.
- (2) Failure to comply with the measures provided for in art. 1-5, art. 7-9 attracts disciplinary, civil, contraventional or criminal liability, in accordance with the provisions of art. 27 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, as subsequently amended and supplemented.
- (3) The personnel of the institutions mentioned in par. (1) is authorized to find contraventions and to apply sanctions, in accordance with the provisions of art. 29 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

#### Article 15

- (1) This military ordinance is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.
- (2) The provisions of art. 4 and 5 of the Military Ordinance no. 2/2020 ceases to apply.
- (3) The audiovisual media service providers have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, for at least 2 days from the date of publication, about the content of this military ordinance.
