

**MILITARY ORDER no. 5 of March 30, 2020 regarding measures to prevent the spread of
COVID-19**

Article 1

(1) The measure of suspension of the flights performed by the aerial economic operators to Spain and from Spain to Romania is extended for a period of 14 days, starting with March 31, 2020 at 18.00.

(2) The measure of suspension of flights performed by airline operators to Italy and from Italy to Romania is extended for a period of 14 days, starting with April 6, 2020.

(3) The measures provided in par. (1) and (2) shall not apply to flights performed by state-owned aircraft, freight and mail, humanitarian or emergency medical services, as well as to non-commercial technical landings.

Article 2

(1) The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications is empowered to ensure the application and compliance with the provisions of art. 1 of this military ordinance.

(2) Failure to comply with the measure provided in art. 1 attracts disciplinary, civil, contraventional or criminal liability, in accordance with the provisions of art. 27 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999 regarding the regime of the state of siege and the regime of the state of emergency, with the subsequent modifications and completions.

(3) The staff of the institution referred to in par. (1) is authorized to find contraventions and to apply sanctions, in accordance with the provisions of art. 29 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

Article 3

(1) Paragraphs (1) and (2) of article 3 of the Military Ordinance no. 4/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 257 of March 29, 2020, shall be amended and shall have the following content:

"(1) The persons who leave the place where they were quarantined, without the approval of the competent authorities, shall be obliged to resume the 14-day cycle of quarantine, bearing the expenses incurred with their quarantine, and shall be criminally liable according to the law.

(2) Persons who do not comply with the conditions of isolation at the declared place / at which they chose to perform the isolation and are identified outside the isolation space shall be obliged to enter quarantine 14 days, bearing the expenses incurred with their quarantine, and will be sanctioned contraventionally according to the provisions of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999 regarding the regime of the state of siege and the regime of the state of emergency, with subsequent modifications and completions, if the deed does not constitute a crime. "

(2) The measure shall be applied from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

Article 4

The provisions of art. 4 of the Military Ordinance no. 4/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, no. 257 of March 29, 2020, does not apply to:

- a) aircraft pilots and navigating personnel flying to and from areas covered by the code "G-WHITE" or without epidemiological risk;
- b) the pilots of aircraft and the navigating personnel flying to and from areas covered by the code "RED area" or with epidemiological risk, which do not descend from aircraft between flights, or wear protective equipment (suit, gloves, glasses, mask), if descending from the aircraft between flights.

Article 5

- (1) This military ordinance is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.
- (2) The audiovisual media service providers have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, for at least two days from the date of publication, about the content of this military ordinance.
