

ORDER no. 6 of March 30, 2020 MILITARY regarding the establishment of the quarantine measure on Suceava municipality, some communes in the neighboring area, as well as a protection zone on administrative-territorial units in Suceava county

Article 1

The quarantine measure is established during the state of emergency in Suceava municipality and in the surrounding area consisting of the following eight communes: Adâncata, Salcea, Ipotești, Bosanci, Moara, Șcheia, Pătrăuți and Mitocu Dragomirnei.

Article 2

During the state of emergency, a protection zone is established, as a safety perimeter around the quarantined localities, consisting of all the other territorial administrative units in Suceava county.

Article 3

In the quarantine zone provided for in art. 1 is allowed the entry or exit for:

- a) freight transport, regardless of its nature, of the raw materials and resources necessary to carry out the economic activities in the quarantine area, as well as to supply the population;
- b) persons who do not live in the quarantined area, but who carry out economic activities or in the field of defense, public order, national security, health, emergency situations, local public administration, welfare and social protection, judiciary, public utility services, energy, agriculture, public food, water supply, communications and transport.

Article 4

The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, as well as economic operators in the field of rail passenger transport will not sell tickets / subscriptions or other travel titles for the transport of passengers in the quarantine area unless the provisions of art. 3.

Article 5

All restrictions established by previous military ordinances are properly applied in quarantined localities and in the protection zone.

Article 6

The County Center for Coordination and Management of Intervention Suceava (CJCCI) is empowered to establish additions and derogations regarding the provisions provided in art. 3.

Article 7

- (1) In the protection zone, the bodies with responsibilities in the field of defense, public order and national security shall establish specific measures to prevent and limit the entry, respectively the exit of the persons in / from the quarantine zone provided in art. 1.
- (2) In the protection zone it is forbidden to move between the localities in the area of persons belonging to other socio-professional categories.
- (3) The authorities of the local and county public administration will inform the persons in the protection zone of their obligations regarding the movement and access in / from the quarantine area.

(4) The application of verification, control and access measures in / from the quarantine area is carried out by the personnel of the structures of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in collaboration with those of the Ministry of National Defense.

Article 8

Access to the international airport "Stefan cel Mare" Suceava is allowed only for flights performed by state aircraft, freight and correspondence flights, humanitarian or emergency medical services, as well as non-commercial technical landings.

Article 9

Suceava County Council together with mayors and local councils from administrative-territorial units located in the quarantine area and the protection area will take measures to ensure the functioning of social protection and welfare services, the proper functioning of public utilities services, as well as the supply of food. basic for people without supporters or other form of assistance and who cannot move from home / household.

Article 10

It is strictly forbidden the access between localities through other areas and access roads than those open to public circulation on the European, national, county and communal roads.

Article 11

(1) I am entitled to ensure the application and observance of the provisions of this military ordinance:

- a) The Romanian police, the Romanian Gendarmerie and the local police, for the measures provided in art. 3;
- b) The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, for the measures provided in art. 4 and 8.

(2) Failure to comply with the measures provided for in art. 3, 4 and 8 attract disciplinary, civil, contraventional or criminal liability, in accordance with the provisions of art. 27 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

(3) The personnel of the institutions mentioned in par. (1) is authorized to find contraventions and to apply sanctions, in accordance with the provisions of art. 29 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

Article 12

(1) This military ordinance is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

(2) The audiovisual media service providers have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, for at least two days from the date of publication, about the content of this military ordinance.
