

**MILITARY ORDINANCE no. 7 of April 4, 2020 regarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19**

CHAPTER I: Establishment of the quarantine measure in the city of Țandărei, Ialomița county

Article 1

During the state of emergency, the quarantine measure is established in the city of Țandărei, Ialomița county.

Article 2

In the quarantined locality provided for in art. 1 are allowed the entry, respectively the exit for:

- a) freight transport, regardless of its nature, of the raw materials and resources necessary to carry out the economic activities in the quarantined locality, as well as the population supply;
- b) persons who do not live in the quarantined area, but who carry out economic activities or in the field of defense, public order, national security, health, emergency situations, local public administration, social assistance and protection, judicial, public utility services, energy, agriculture, public food, water supply, communications and transport.

Article 3

Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, as well as economic operators in the field of passengers rail transport will not sell tickets / season tickets or other travel tickets for the transportation of passengers in the quarantined locality unless the provisions of art. 2.

Article 4

In the quarantined locality according to art. 1 all the prohibitions and restrictions established by

military ordinances issued during the period of emergency are applicable.

Article 5

The Ialomita County Intervention Coordination and Management Center (CJCCI) is empowered to establish additions and derogations regarding the provisions provided in art. 2, with the approval of the County Committee for Emergency Situations.

Article 6

(1) The bodies with responsibilities in the field of defense, public order and national security shall establish specific measures for preventing and limiting the entry, respectively the exit of the persons in / from the quarantined locality.

(2) The authorities of the local and county public administration will bring to light the obligations incumbent upon the persons, regarding the movement and access to / from the quarantined locality.

(3) The application of the verification, control and access measures in / from the quarantined locality is carried out by the personnel structures of the Ministry of Internal Affairs in collaboration with those of the Ministry of National Defense.

#### Article 7

The Ialomița County Council, the mayor and the Local Council of the City of Tândărei will take measures to ensure the functioning of social protection and welfare services, the proper functioning of public utilities services, as well supply of basic food for people without supporters or other forms of assistance and who cannot move from home / household.

#### Article 8

It is strictly forbidden to enter / exit in / from the city of Tândărei, Ialomița county, through areas and access roads other than those open to public circulation on European, national, county and communal roads.

### CHAPTER II: Other measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19

#### Article 9

(1) All flights by air operators to Austria, Belgium, the Swiss Confederation, , United States of America, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, Kingdom of the Netherlands, Turkey and Iran and from these countries to Romania, for all airports in Romania, for a period of 14 days, are suspended.

(2) The measure shall be applied from April 5, 2020, at 23.00, the time of Romania.

(3) The measure of suspension of flights performed by airline operators to France and Germany and from these countries to Romania, for a period of 14 days, shall be extended starting with April 8, 2020.

(4) The measures provided in par. (1) and (3) do not apply to flights performed by state aircraft, to transport flights freight and correspondence, humanitarian or providing emergency medical services, as well as technical landings Associations.

#### Article 10

(1) The flights performed by all air carriers through irregular charter flights are allowed for transport of seasonal workers from Romania to other states, with the approval of the competent authorities of the country of destination.

(2) The provisions of para. (1) does not apply to workers who work in the field of health and social care.

#### Article 11

International road transport of persons is suspended through regular services, special regular services and occasional services in international traffic, for all the flights performed by the transport operators to Italy, Spain, France, Germany, Austria, Belgium, Swiss Confederation, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland, United Kingdom, The Netherlands and Turkey and from these countries to Romania, throughout the state of emergency.

## Article 12

At the entrance to Romania, the drivers of the freight vehicles with the maximum authorized maximum capacity of 2.4 tonnes, which do not show symptoms associated with COVID-19, complete a declaration on their own responsibility, whose model is established by the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, by which they assume the location where they can be contacted between races. They are not subject to the isolation measures at home / quarantine, provided that they are providing the employer with individual protective materials against COVID-19.

## Article 13

The provisions of art. 12 properly applies to drivers of cargo vehicles with a maximum authorized capacity greater than 2.4 tonnes that travel in the interest of pursuing their Romanian profession in another member state of the European Union or from another state of the European Union in Romania, as a state of residence of the driver, regardless of whether the journey is on board the freight vehicle or by individual means of their own account. They must present, upon entering Romania, an employee certificate, assumed by the employer.

## Article 14

(1) Drivers of freight vehicles with a maximum authorized capacity greater than 2.4 tonnes, which transit through the territory of Romania, are not obliged to complete, upon entry into the territory of Romania, the epidemiological declaration, if they meet the following minimum conditions:

- a) uses only transit corridors and points for crossing the state border located at the ends of these corridors, approved by the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications and the Ministry of Internal Affairs, deviation from these being prohibited;
- b) the transit of the territory of Romania is made in a minimum time interval, without exceeding 48 hours from the entry into Romania, including the periods of stay for the normal daily rest;
- c) the parking of the vehicle is done exclusively in parking lots located on the transit corridors, marked in a suitable way.

(2) In case of non-observance of the conditions stipulated in par. (1), the driver of the vehicle will be forced to quarantine 14 days, bearing the expenses incurred with his quarantine. In this case, the vehicle can be taken by a representative of the holder.

(3) Upon entering Romania, the driver is obliged to apply, on the glazed parts of the vehicle (windscreen), a special sticker made available by the State Inspectorate for Control in Road Transport, respectively to keep on it the transit form whose model is established by the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications.

## Article 15

The provisions of art. 5 of the Military Ordinance no. 3/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in The Official Monitor of Romania, Part I, no. 242 of March 24, 2020, does not apply to locomotive drivers and railway staff.

## Article 16

(1) The ministries with their own sanitary network and the local public administration authorities will provide, on request, hotel spaces intended for rest between shifts or guards for personnel in the public health system, in order to prevent the spread of the COVID-19 virus.

(2) The measure shall be applied from the date of publication of this military ordinance in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

#### Article 17

(1) The personnel of the territorial and county forestry guards or with control / guard duties on the forest line will participate in the devices of public order and traffic control on public roads, together with the personnel of the Ministry of Internal Affairs and of the Ministry of National Defense, in order to carry out specific activities / controls on the forestry control line.

(2) The specific controls are made at the existing control points, depending on the personnel available at the forestry guard level or forestry control / guard duties.

#### CHAPTER III: Final provisions

#### Article 18

(1) Are entitled to ensure the application and observance of the provisions of the present military ordinance:

a) The Romanian police, the Romanian Gendarmerie and the local police, for the measures provided in art. 2 and 8;

b) The Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure and Communications, for the measures provided in art. 3 and 9;

c) The Romanian Border Police, for the measures provided in art. 11 and 13;

d) Romanian Police, Romanian Border Police and Romanian Gendarmerie, local police, public health departments and the leaders of the local public administration authorities, for the measure provided in art. 12;

e) Romanian Police, Romanian Border Police, Romanian Gendarmerie and State Inspectorate for Control in Road Transport, for the measure provided in art. 14.

(2) Failure to comply with the measures provided for in art. 2, 3, 8, 9 and 11-14 attract disciplinary, civil, contraventional or criminal liability, in accordance with the provisions of art. 27 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, with subsequent amendments.

(3) The personnel of the institutions mentioned in par. (1) is authorized to find contraventions and to apply sanctions, in accordance with the provisions of art. 29 of the Government Emergency Ordinance no. 1/1999, with the subsequent modifications and completions.

#### Article 19

The provisions of art. 4 of the Military Ordinance no. 4/2020 on measures to prevent the spread of COVID-19, published in

The Official Monitor of Romania, Part I, no. 257 of March 29, 2020, ceases to apply.

Article 20

(1) This military ordinance is published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I.

(2) The audiovisual media service providers have the obligation to inform the public, through regularly broadcast messages, for at least two days from the date of publication, about the contents of this military ordinance.
